

GUIDELINES FOR LOCKER ROOM USE DURING RENOVATIONS

- 1. All Y members, guests and program participants will be using the Men's or Women's locker rooms during the renovation project.
- 2. A locker room attendant will be posted in each locker room during peak times to assist children when their parent/guardian is not present. Peak times are defined as: Monday thru Friday 3:30 pm to 8:30 pm; Saturday 8:30 am to 6:00 pm; and Sunday 10:00 am to 6:00 pm.
- 3. Both the Men's and Women's locker rooms will have three (3) aisles with curtains that can be drawn to provide privacy. Parents with children and unattended children should use the aisle(s) designated. Any questions can be directed to the locker room attendant.



- 4. Children 5 years of age and younger, that are accompanied by a parent/guardian, will still be permitted in opposite gender locker rooms. Please use the aisle(s) designated.
- 5. Children 6 years of age and older must use the same gender locker room. A locker room attendant is scheduled during peak times to provide assistance if their parent/guardian is of the opposite gender. Peak times are defined as: Monday thru Friday 3:30 pm to 8:30 pm; Saturday 8:30 am to 6:00 pm; and Sunday 10:00 am to 6:00 pm.
- 6. Use of the saunas is limited to members, participants and guests 15 years of age and older.
- 7. Remember to lock valuables while in the YMCA as we are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Code of Conduct
